**BY HISTORIC WORKSHOPS**

- VI. PLAN A TRAINING SCHEDULE FOR AIR-RAID WARDENS TO INCREASE THEIR LEVELS OF FITNESS. DEMONSTRATE THIS TO THE REST OF THE CLASS.**
- VII. DESIGN AND MAKE AN AIR-RAID SHELTER.**
- VIII. MAKE RATION BOOKS.**
- IX. CREATE A MEAL OUT OF ALLOCATED RATIONS.**
- X. USING CHALK, MARK OUT THE SIZE OF A DOODLE-BUG ON THE PLAYGROUND.**
- XI. PLAN AND CREATE A V.E DAY CELEBRATION.**
- XII. WRITE A POEM TO HELP PEOPLE REMEMBER THE SACRIFICES OF PEOPLE DURING THE WAR.**
